Parents/carers/guests will be able to view the entries that morning after the Easter Services and a letter will come out to that effect nearer the time.

Pupils are encouraged to create something at home and bring their entries in during the week starting Monday 1<sup>st</sup> April. Please do not send anything in before due to lack of storage facilities!

I appreciate that some pupils will struggle to create pieces at home and students will be given a small amount of time and help at school to make something. If pupils wish to bring any materials into school e.g a bonnet and items to decorate it with then please make sure they are sent in for Monday 25<sup>th</sup> March as some specific time has been set aside for this purpose.

I look forward to seeing the pupils' creations and look forward to welcoming you into school for the Easter Services on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> April.
