	Points Raised:
Items from last meeting	<p>Update on Tuck Shop. SJ to discuss this further with SLT and the kitchen. To feed back to working party on this before next Student Council meeting. Members are: O, M, K, R.</p> <p>Can we have more accessible activities for wheelchair users on the adventure playground. Due to school activities for Halloween, this did not happen. We will rearrange this for week beginning Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> November SJ, SR E, K, I, N.</p> <p>Sixth Form Common Room: SRS to email KJ to arrange a meeting about this with the working party: A, K, M, A, O and M.</p>

1	<p>As we are now in bubbles, can classes rotate at break and lunchtime so all classes have chance to use the Muga. SR to speak with KJ about this.</p>
2	<p>We would like to do more for the environment and are concerned about the amount of rubbish we produce and would like to recycle it. BA is collecting crisp packets, which will be made into blankets for homeless people. K will research this and send ideas to SR and talk about these at the next meeting.</p>
3	<p>Could we have a later start for lesson 4 as students are having to rush after lunch. Some students find it difficult to settle into class, and this also disrupts other students making it difficult. SJ to discuss this at SLT on 18.11.21 and feedback at next meeting.</p>
4	<p>Why isn't the wheelchair swing open and can we have another one on the adventure playground. SR spoke with K and the swing has been repaired and can be used. If students want to use the swing, a member of the class staff needs to get the key from K and then supervise the swing in use. The swing needs to be kept locked as it has been damaged by students (who could also hurt themselves.) The current swing is not accessible to all wheel users as not all chairs will fit the swing. This has been passed to the Playground Development Group to add to discuss.</p> <p>Can the squeak on the bird's nest swing be fixed? SR spoke with K and K/S will oil the swing.</p>

5	<p>Could we have different items on our menu please?  K spoke about the following suggestions:  A full English breakfast.  Not have pasta on the menu every Monday  A choice of baguettes/wraps</p> <p>K brought up the temperature of the food-SJH will discuss this with the kitchen. SR said a good idea would be to tell the kitchen/and adult at the time so they have a hot meal.</p> <p>Could we have pancakes added to the dessert menu.</p>
6	<p>Can we improve our toilet areas-more bins, air freshener and could they be cleaned more often?  SR spoke with K:  There is a bin in each toilet area and the bins is emptied each day after school. J also empties the bins sometimes in the school day. Students please be careful with the amount of hand towels you use-don't take lots from the hand dispenser. Think of the environment!</p> <p>K will cost automatic air fresheners for the toilet areas.  Toilets are cleaned at the end of every school day. If you find the toilets are dirty when you go in please tell your class staff. Also, make sure that the toilet is clean and tidy when you leave it.</p>
7	<p>There were a lot of ideas for the playground area. SR will send these to the Playground Development.  These were:  Can the Sixth Form have a basketball hoop.  Can we have more swings.</p>

	<p>Outdoor trampoline like what you have in a park. Could we have swings scattered around the playground. Ping pong table Painted track on the playground</p>
